This year's Hope for the Holidays Projects were a wonderful success! Special thanks to the many corporate sponsors, businesses and individuals

Our Adopt-A-Family project brought Christmas cheer to the families with children who have experienced homelessness and are now in Next Move programs. Wilma's Place Reopens

Next Move and WEAVE have teamed up to provide shelter for women and families who are victims of domestic violence.

Both organizations are committed to ensuring those in vulnerable living environments, including homelessness, move toward self-sufficiency and stability. Next Move had space from a program for which we no longer had funding, and WEAVE has funding for a new program but needed space to house their clients.



With significant support from Goodwill, we renovated Wilma's Place, formerly used as an extension of our women's emergency shelter program. One or more families will live at Wilma's Place while they work toward self-reliance through WEAVE's supportive service programs.
